Please note. The following Covid requirements will be in place. If you are unwilling to follow these requirements, you will not be allowed to remain, even if you have paid for your seats.

1. **EVERYONE ATTENDING SERVICES MUST MAKE AN ADVANCE RESERVATION.** No one will be allowed to attend without a reservation.
2. We have purchased a Shabbat Thermometer. Before anyone enters the prayer space, they must have their temperature taken and it must read normal.
3. All chairs will be assigned a number, and all attendees will be assigned a chair to use throughout. Family members of the same sex will have their chairs together, but all others will be spaced at least six feet apart.
4. Each person attending services will be given a book inside a plastic bag, with their name on the bag. You will be responsible to take the book home after services and return with it for the next service you attend.
5. Everyone attending services will be required to wear a mask at all times. One will be provided if you do not bring one with you.
6. At the end of services, we will empty the prayer space one row at a time to insure keeping our social distancing.

7. In between each service, a cleaning crew will come into the prayer space and bathrooms and sanitize everything.

Eve Levy will have separate lessons during Rosh Hashana and Yom Kippur. They will be held in a separate space at the Hillsdale building. Please register for these also as social distancing, temperature taking, and masks will be required. Space will be limited as a result. If you register for only Eve's lesson, you will not be allowed into the sanctuary space. A list of the topics and the exact location in the building for the classes will be sent out to those registered. There will be no charge for attending these classes.
